This letter is to support and encourage participation in the upcoming National Tuberculosis Coalition of America Conference (NTC) for recipients of federal funding under CDC-RFA-PS25-0003: CDC Tuberculosis Elimination and Laboratory Cooperative Agreement and CDC-RFA-PS23-2302: Accelerating the Prevention and Control of HIV, Viral Hepatitis, STDs, and TB in the U.S.-Affiliated Pacific Islands. Ideally, each funded program should send at least one representative to the conference. The 2026 NTC will be held on June 8-12, 2026, in Palm Springs, California.
